


The Mass of St. Lawrence of Brindisi

The original Mass of St. Lawrence of Brindisi was composed by Br. Carmel flora OFMCap in approximately 1970 – 71. There is no copyright on the original pencil manuscript but it marks the time Br. Carmel began as Novice Master in St. Lawrence of Brindisi friary at Wynnum North, Queensland. The text used is that of the Roman Missal of that era and the music simply consisted of a 'Lord, have mercy', a 'Holy, holy', and a 'Lamb of God'.

Subsequently, I have added a Memorial Acclamation and Amen using the 2010 translation of the Roman Missal. At the same time the text (and part of the melody) of the Holy, holy has also been adapted to suit the 2010 text.


